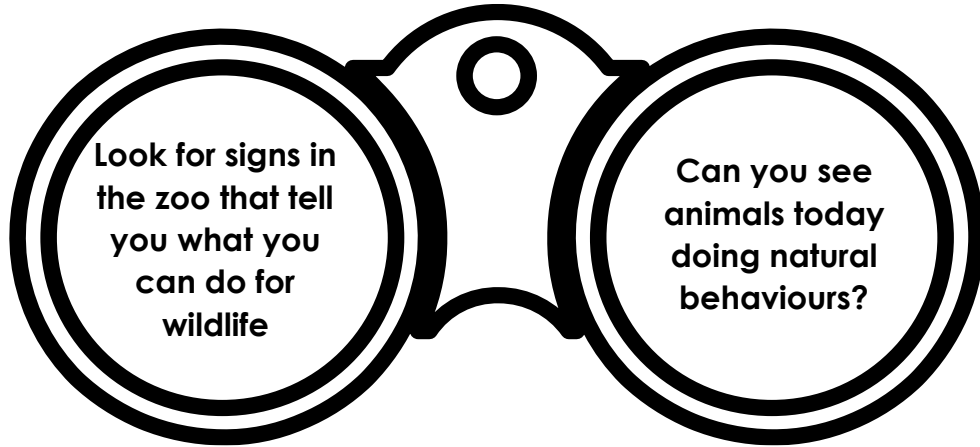


Protecting our world
